

Lutheran Bible Translators of Canada 2012 Project Proposals To Consider



Project 1 Support for Rev Mike and Kara Kuhn - Canada

LBTC is pleased to announce that Rev Mike and Kara Kuhn continue to complete linguistics training in 2012. Later in the year, they will begin Partnership Development. At this stage, they will seek congregational support for their first assignment in Cameroon with the Nizaa Language Project.

\$2,000 per month is needed for a total of \$24,000 (for 2012)

Project 2 Support for Doowaayo Language Project - Cameroon

In the fall of 2011, the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Cameroon (ELCC) placed Aubert Kpengapse, as translator to the Doowaayo Language Project. Aubert will manage an office and language committee in Poli, Cameroon and begin to revise the Doowaayo Old Testament. Costs include salaries, rent, office equipment and supplies, travel to conferences, etc. Aubert reports Rev Daniel Touka of ELCC and to LBT/LBTC. It is expected this project to continue for about 10 years.

\$800 per month is needed for a total of \$9,600 (2012 - 2022)

Project 3 Support for Kwanja Language Project - Cameroon

The Kwanja Language Project includes the continuation of the Old Testament Lectionary readings and literacy projects now started in many Kwanja communities. The Kwanja Old Testament translation will also continue.

The 2012 budget includes training of new leaders through workshops, travel to remote villages and other communications, as well as salaries and office costs for staff who provide the translation and training

now. We expect certain aspects of this project to continue for a minimum of 5 years.

\$825 per month is needed for a total of \$9,900 (2012 - 2017 and beyond)

Project 4 Support for Shiyeyi Language Project - Botswana

The Shiyeyi Language Project includes language learning and completion of the New Testament books.

The 2012 budget that LBTC will support includes about 10% of Eshinee and Rob Veith's total costs. We expect this project to continue for a minimum of 10 years.

\$500 per month is needed for a total of \$6,000 (2012 - 2022)

Project 5 Support for Weber Furlough in Canada

Martin and Joan Weber are in North America in 2012. They will visit eastern Canada April through June, travelling westward to be in Saskatchewan and BC in July and then later in August throughout BC. Their living costs are absorbed in part by a number of Weber partners, but also other costs are expected. This furlough will last for one year only.

\$4,700 is needed for 2012
